UNIVERSITY ADMISSION

- 1. Complete the undergraduate transfer application at applytexas.org.
- 2. Pay the non-refundable application fee or attend a transfer day for an application fee voucher.
- 3. Submit final official transcript(s) from ALL college level institutions previously attended.

PROGRAM ADMISSION

- 1. Have a current unencumbered Texas Registered Nurse's (RN) license or of a Compact State, or be in the last semester of an associate degree program in nursing.
- 2. Have completed all or be within six (6) hours of completing non-nursing transfer courses required for the BSN degree.
- 3. Have earned a "C" or higher in all transfer courses applicable to the BSN degree.
- 4. Complete the Application to the Nursing Program.
- 5. Submit reference form.
