Dear Dr. Nigliazzo:

Thank you again for the hospitality and assistance extended to the Accreditation Committee during its recent visit to Texas A&M University on May 13-15, 2013. Enclosed is the final report prepared by the Committee.

The report represents the professional judgment of the Accreditation Committee made in accordance with the *Principles of Accreditation: Foundations for Quality Enhancement* and subject to review by the Commission on Colleges and its standing review committees – the Committees on Compliance and Reports. Some parts of the report are directly related to the requirements of the *Principles*, while others may represent advisory comments offered by the visiting committee in a spirit of helpfulness. A formal recommendation is included when a visiting committee judges that the institution does not comply with any of the sections of the *Principles*. All recommendations included in a visiting committee report have been adopted by the total committee and require an institutional response.

The Commission on Colleges and its Committees on Compliance and Reports meet officially in June and in December. Final decisions on accreditation are made public following each meeting. The report of the committee which visited Texas A&M University will be reviewed at the **June 2013** meeting.

An institution may release its visiting committee report; however, release of this report in its entirety or in part must be accompanied by the following statement: “The findings of this visiting committee represent a preliminary assessment of the institution at this time; final action on the report rests with the Commission on Colleges.” If the institution releases part of its report, that part must contain a note stating: “A copy of the entire report can be obtained from the institution.”
