Dear Dr. Kirk:

The purpose of this letter is to clarify the institution's distance learning approval and to clarify the status of five off-campus instructional sites. This information is based on discussions between you and your Commission representative Dr. Crystal A. Baird.

Distance Learning

The institution is approved to offer 50% or more of any approved program by distance learning. Distance learning approval was included in the approval for membership as a separate entity, effective January 1, 2013.

Off-campus Instructional Sites

We sent an accreditation verification letter to President Nigliazzo dated October 4, 2013, in which five off-campus instructional sites were noted as offering less than 25% of a program. The letter should have noted the sites as offering 25-49% of a program. We regret the error. The sites are:

Should the institution begin to offer 50% or more of the credit for at least one program at an off-campus instructional site, a prospectus for approval of the site should be submitted prior to reaching the 50% threshold at the site.
