Thank you for your letter of July 13, 2017, and additional information provided by email on January 17, 2018, providing notification of the closure of four off-campus sites, effective August 1, 2017.

Students taking courses at the Center, which is approximately nine miles from the main campus of the University, were notified via email that the SDC site would be closed. They were advised to visit school program counselors who would assist with issues related to tuition assistance and VA benefits. No programs were closed as a result of the closure and students will be able to continue their studies and graduate as planned. Faculty members were not impacted by the closure as all full-time faculty members teaching at the site have teaching duties at the main campus.


