Thank you for your letter of October 17, 2018, notifying the Commission of the intent to reopen the following off-campus instructional sites for Gatesville Prison, effective fall 2019, as verified in your e-mail of January 11, 2019:

Murray Unit

Mountainview Unit  
2305 Ransom Road  
Gatesville, TX 76528  
25-49% instructional level

Alfred D. Hughes Unit  
3201 FM 929  
Gatesville, TX 76599  
>50% instructional level

Riverside/Crane Unit  
1401 State School Road  
Gatesville, TX 76599  
25-49% instructional level

Approval to close the sites was noted in a Commission letter dated October 30, 2017. Since that time, the Texas Department of Criminal Justice has asked the educational programs at the Gatesville Prison sites be reestablished pending SACSCOC approval.

**We accept notification to re-open the Gatesville Prison sites noted above. The sites were closed, effective fall 2017, and will be re-opened, effective fall 2019, fewer than five years after closure.**
