15.01.01.D1 Administration of Sponsored Agreements-Research and Other

Rule Summary

Sponsored agreements establish requirements for accepting funds in support of a specific project or program. The requirements included in these agreements usually specify time periods for expending funds and contain provisions for financial and technical reporting and intellectual property assignments, including patents and copyrights. This rule provides guidance to reduce the likelihood of improperly executed or managed sponsored activities.

Rule

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 All sponsored agreements at Texas A&M University-Central Texas (A&M-Central Texas) shall be handled in accordance with System Policy 15.01, Research Agreements and System Regulation 15.01.01, Sponsored Agreements Research and Other.
- 1.2 Research grant and contract application submissions at A&M-Central Texas have been delegated for processing to Sponsored Research Services (SRS) in College Station, with any exceptions to this approved by the Chief Research Officer at A&M-Central Texas, who has been delegated authority by the President/CEO at A&M-Central Texas to address research-related issues.

2. EFFORT REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 For each pay period, it is the delegated responsibility of the assigned Principal Investigator (PI) to accurately track, record, and certify the time and effort on sponsored activities in accordance to the requirements of System Regulation 15.01.01, Sponsored Agreements Research and Other.
- 2.2 The procedures and processes used in the sponsored activities are detailed in A&M-Central Texas Procedure 15.01.01.D1.01 *Administration of Sponsored Agreements Research and Other*.
