24.01.01.D1.08 Restrictions on Candles and Similar Items

Procedure Summary

Texas A&M University–Central Texas (A&M Central Texas) is committed to maintaining a safe environment for all, and fire prevention is a critical component of that commitment. Candles, incense burners, oil lamps, and similar items having open flame or smolder represent an unnecessary and unacceptable risk to the safety of the people and facilities of the university.

Procedure

1. GENERAL

1.1 This procedure shall be enforced in all facilities owned by A&M Central Texas as well as in areas within leased facilities occupied by A&M Central Texas personnel.

2. RESTRICTIONS

- 2.1 Candles, incense burners, oil lamps, or other personal items that have open flames are prohibited in all campus buildings.
 - 2.1.1 Items having an open flame are permissible in classrooms or labs where the nature of the instruction demands the use of open flame devices.
- 2.2 This restriction does not apply to those items and uses therof as addressed by (SAP 24.01.01.D1.02, Use of Pyrotechnics or Flame Effects) nor to such devices approved for use in the course and within the scope of University sponsored research or activities necessary for continued business operations.
- 2.3 Exemptions may be requested, in writing, from the Office of Safety and Risk Management.

3. RESPONSIBILITES

3.1 All faculty, staff, and students are responsible for adherence to this procedure.

- 3.2 Supervisors are responsible for communicating this procedure to all departmental personnel, for enforcing this policy, and ensuring that prohibited items, when identified, are removed from the workplace.
- 3.3 Safety and Risk Management is responsible for interpreting and clarifying this procedure and reporting prohibited items found in the workplace as deficiencies that require departmental corrective action.
