Alcoholic Beverages on University Property

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Procedure Statement

The purchase, service, possession, and consumption of alcoholic beverages in facilities under the control of Texas A&M University–Central Texas (A&M-Central Texas) shall, in all aspects, comply with state law and the guidelines established under System Policy [34.03 Alcoholic Beverages](#).

Reason for Procedure

This procedure provides guidance for the purchase, service, possession, and consumption of alcoholic beverages on the A&M-Central Texas campus and supplements System Policy [34.03 Alcoholic Beverages](#).

Procedures and Responsibilities

1. POSSESSION OR USE

- 1.1 The University prohibits the use or possession of alcoholic beverages on campus by any individual under the age of 21. Failure to comply with this violates state law and the rules governing student conduct, and will subject the individual to disciplinary action.
- 1.2 The possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages by persons of legal drinking age is permitted only at university-sanctioned events held at designated locations.
- 1.3 In all cases, possession or use of alcohol must be in full compliance with applicable state laws, including the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code.

2. RESPONSIBILITY AND PURCHASES

- 2.1 The President must pre-approve all purchases of alcohol, and designate which areas will be used for consumption.

2.2 All purchases of alcoholic beverages must comply with Section 2 of System Policy *34.03 Alcoholic Beverages*.

2.3 State funds cannot be used to purchase alcohol for personal consumption or entertainment.
