DEGREE SPECIFICS

The Bachelor of Science in Liberal Studies degree consists of two required courses in Liberal Studies, LIBS 3300 Intro to Liberal Studies and LIBS 4395 Liberal Studies capstone, and three minors of 18 hours each. The required courses prepare students to engage classes as an interdisciplinary student. The capstone creates space for students to reflect on the ideas and direct the skills acquired in the three minors toward their career and professional objectives.

All minors require 18 credit hours of coursework. Students can usually apply up to 6 semester credit hours of lower-level coursework in most minors. All minors require at least 12 semester credit hours of upper-level coursework. The BSLS is your degree, so select the combination of minors that works for you.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- » Pay non-refundable application fee
- » Submit official transcripts from all previously attended college-level institutions

UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- » Minimum 2.0 cumulative transfer GPA on a 4.0 scale
- » Minimum 30 academic, college-level transferable hours
- » Must be eligible to return to all previously attended institutions
