- » Minimum 2.0 cumulative transfer GPA on a 4.0 scale
- » Minimum 30 academic, college-level transferable hours
- » Must be eligible to return to all previously attended institutions

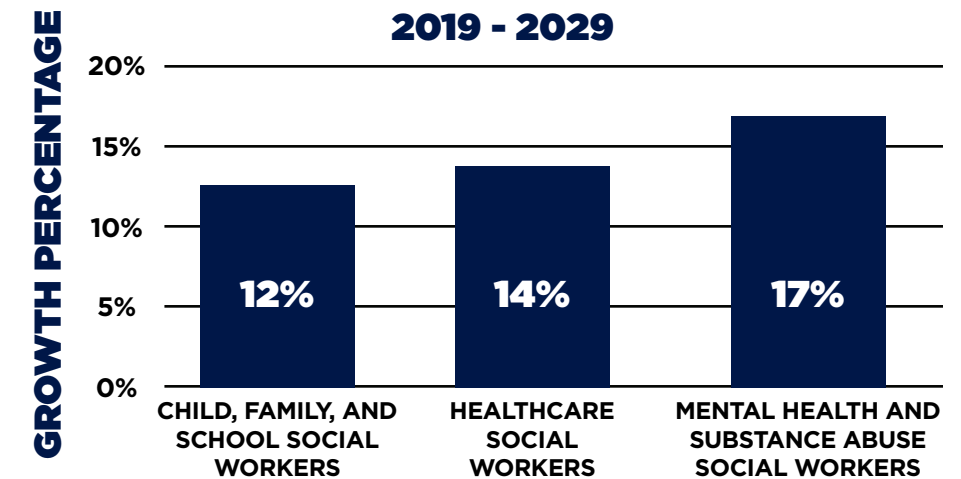

AN IN-DEMAND CAREER

Employment of social workers is projected to grow 13 percent from 2019 to 2029, much faster than the average for all occupations, according to the US Bureau of Labor Statistics. Before 2029, the US will need more than 90,000 new social workers. Median pay for all social work positions was nearly \$52,000 in 2020.
