- ▶ Submit final transcripts from all institutions previously attended.
- ▶ Pay the non-refundable application fee via your electronic application or through our Business office.
- ▶ Must have at least 3.0 GPA (2.5-2.99 requires GRE/GMAT, or conditional admit for 12 hours)
- ▶ Must hold baccalaureate degree or higher from an accredited college or university.
