- » Pay the non-refundable application fee via your electronic application or through our Business Office.
- » Must hold baccalaureate degree or higher from an accredited college or university.
- » Submit final transcripts from all institutions previously attended.
- » Must have at least 3.0 GPA (2.5-2.99 requires GRE/GMAT, or conditional admit for 12 hours).
- » See individual departments for additional program admission requirements.
