PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting at Texas A&M University-Central Texas provides students a rigorous course of study in a supportive setting. Students will achieve the technical proficiency and professionalism needed to continue into graduate study or begin a rewarding career. The program prepares students to satisfy the requirements to sit for the CPA Exam, or for entry-level careers in accounting that do not require licensure as a CPA.

Students have the flexibility to focus on courses that meet specific career objectives and related certifications, such as:

- Certified Public Accountant (CPA)
- Certified Management Accountant (CMA)
- Certified Internal Auditor (CIA)

The degree meets the Texas State Board of Public Accountancy (TSBPA) requirements of a minimum of 15 hours of face-to-face instruction. Students will only need to take the Accounting Research course to complete the accounting and business course requirements for the CPA examination.
