Lower Level Electives, Any Level Electives or Degree Requirements (DEG REQ) may consist of the FOS courses: MUSI 1311, MUSI 1312, MUSI 2311, MUSI 2312, MUSI 1116, MUSI 1117, MUSI 2116, MUSI 2117, MUSI 2312, MUSI 1116, MUSI 1117, MUSI 2116, MUSI 2117, MUSI 1307, 4 credit hours MUEN ensemble, 8 credit hours MUAP applied study.
- 5. Summer semesters may be required to meet degree requirements throughout the program.
- 6. Upper level electives may consists of up to 6 credits of Fine Arts electives with approval of the advisor in place of MUSI upper level electives.
