4. Lower Level Electives, Any Level Electives or Degree Requirements (DEG REQ) may consist of the FOS courses: MUSI 1311, MUSI 1312, MUSI 2311, MUSI 2312, MUSI 1116, MUSI 1117, MUSI 2116, MUSI 2117, MUSI 1307, 4 credit hours MUEN ensemble, 8 credit hours MUAP applied study.
5. Please note the following courses require a grade of 'C' or better: 12 credit hours of English, College Algebra, approved Educational Psychology course, and 15 credit hours in the certification subject area.
6. Summer semesters may be required to meet degree requirements throughout the program.
