



### Authorization for Non-Standard Charges

Federal regulations require Texas A&M University-Central Texas (TAMUCT) to apply your Title IV financial aid funds to allowable educationally related charges. Educationally related charges include tuition, fees, and room and board (if the student contracts with the school). TAMUCT also allows other departments to assess non-standard charges to your student account in order to consolidate billing. Some of these non-standard charges might include; but are not limited to, parking, library fines, late registration fees, and late payment fees. Under federal regulations, TAMUCT must obtain your authorization to apply your Title IV financial aid to non-standard charges appearing on your student account.

Authorizations are in effect for the entire respective aid year for which you are seeking to receive financial aid. Authorizations may be canceled at any time by submitting a written request to the Office of Student Financial Assistance. Any request to cancel an authorization received by the Office of Student Financial Assistance will be effective the following business day.

If TAMUCT is not authorized to apply Title IV financial aid, you will be responsible for any non-standard charges. Failure to remit payment by the due date may result in an assessment of late fees, a hold on registration and academic records, and cancellation of any preregistration.
