1. Not all Degree Requirement courses are completed with the AA. Student will need to complete these remaining lower-level courses at the community college. Please consult a TAMUCT financial aid counselor regarding the consortium agreement process.
2. Any-level electives may be taken at either at Texas A&M University-Central Texas or another institution. Please consult an academic advisor prior to selecting any-level electives.
3. Adding an Education Minor will increase the total credits and possibly the length to complete the degree. Please consult an academic advisor if interested in adding Education as a minor.
4. Upper-level electives may consist of up to 6 credits of Fine Arts electives with approval of the advisor in place of MUSI upper-level electives.
