1. 12 hours of a Foreign Language or 12 hours of any combination of upper-level Linguistics or Foreign Language courses.
2. For the BA Degree but not the AA Degree, you must take Child Psychology (PSYC 2308) or Child Growth & Development (TECA 1354).
3. Please note the following courses require a grade of 'C' or better: 12 credit hours of English, College Algebra, approved Educational Psychology course, and 15 credit hours in the certification subject area.
