4. Any-level electives may be taken at either Texas A&M University-Central Texas or another institution. Please consult an academic advisor prior to selecting any-level electives.
5. May include 3 hours of lower-level courses; otherwise, all electives are upper-level.
6. May include 9 hours of lower-level courses; otherwise, all electives are upper-level. The Department of Social Sciences includes Anthropology, Criminal Justice, Political Science, Religious Studies, and Sociology. Students may choose from any combination of these disciplines.
