- The AAT does not fulfill all the lower-level courses required for the undergraduate degree. Students will need to complete these remaining lower-level courses at Austin Community College. Please discuss the consortium agreement procedure with a TAMUCT <u>financial aid advisor</u>. Select from ENGL 2322, ENGL 2323, ENGL 2327, ENGL 2328, ENGL 2332, ENGL 2333, ENGL 2341, OR ENGL 2351.
- Biology elective excludes Nutrition.
- Students may fulfill this degree requirement by enrolling in ENGL 3320 or ENGL 3330 at TAMUCT.
- Courses may be taken during the summer.
- The following courses require a grade of 'C' or better: 12 credit hours of English, College Algebra, and approved Educational Psychology course and completion of 15 credit hours in the certification subject area.
