A minimum of 120 semester credit hours is required for all baccalaureate degrees. Pathways may exceed 120 semester credit hours as some courses necessary for the associate degree are transferable but not applicable to the baccalaureate degree. For help with pathway planning, students should speak with an academic advisor or enrollment specialist . This pathway is intended for planning and visualization purposes and is subject to change.	
1.	The AA does not meet all the course requirements for the bachelor's degree. Students will need to complete the remaining lower-level courses at Temple College. It is recommended to seek guidance from a financial aid advisor regarding the consortium agreement process.
