Pathways may exceed 120 semester credit hours as some courses necessary for the associate degree are transferable but not applicable to the baccalaureate degree. All other students may select either EDUC 1300, HUMA 1301 topic course Great Questions Seminar, SPCH 1311, or SPCH 1315. 2.	The AA does not fulfill all the lower-level courses required for the undergraduate degree. Students will need to complete these remaining lower-level courses at ACC. Please discuss the consortium agreement procedure with a TAMUCT financial aid advisor .
