All other students may select either HUMA 1301 topic course Great Questions Seminar, EDUC 1100, EDUC 1300, or a speech course from Component Area Option section of the Core Curriculum Course List. See an advisor or a full-time faculty member in English for more information.
2.	The AA does not fulfill all the lower-level courses required for the undergraduate degree. Students will need to complete these remaining lower-level courses at ACC. Please discuss the consortium agreement procedure with a TAMUCT <a href="#">financial aid advisor</a> .
3.	Any-level electives may be taken at TAMUCT or at ACC. Please consult with an <a href="#">academic advisor</a> prior to selecting any-level electives.
