**Notes/Comments**

TAMUCT offers upper-level courses (3xxx-5xxx labeled courses), all lower-level courses (1xxx-2xxx labeled courses) will need to be completed at ACC. A minimum of 120 semester credit hours is required for all baccalaureate degrees. Pathways may exceed 120 semester credit hours as some courses necessary for the associate degree are transferable but not applicable to the baccalaureate degree. - All first time Austin Community College (ACC) students with fewer than 12 SCH of successful college credit must take HUMA 1301 topic course Great Questions Seminar or EDUC 1100 success course in their first semester at ACC. All other students may select either HUMA 1301 topic course Great Questions Seminar, EDUC 1100, EDUC 1300, or a speech course from Component Area Option section of the Core Curriculum Course List. See an advisor or a full-time faculty member in English for more information.
- The AA does not fulfill all the lower-level courses required for the undergraduate degree. Students will need to complete these remaining lower-level courses at ACC. Please discuss the consortium agreement procedure with a TAMUCT [financial aid advisor](#).
- 12 hours of a Foreign Language or 12 hours of any combination of upper-level Linguistics or Foreign Language courses.
- The following courses require a grade of 'C' or better: 12 credit hours of English, College Algebra, approved Educational Psychology course, and 15 credit hours in the certification subject area.
