Pathways may exceed 120 semester credit hours, as certain courses required for the associate degree are transferable but not applicable to the baccalaureate degree. May consist of technical, vocational, or military credit (or a combination) No student will be considered for the BAAS who has less than 12 semester credit hours in the combination of technical, vocational, or military training (12 hours must be technical/vocational training if no military training) With the qualifying 12 semester credit hours, a student may include specified academic electives up to the maximum 36 semester credit hours.
