2. Lower-Level Electives, Any Level Electives, Component Area Options, or Degree Requirements (DEG REQ) may consist of the FOS courses: PSYC 2301, PYSC 2314, PSYC 2317, PSYC 2319, PSYC 2320, PSYC 2330.
3. A minimum of 12 semester credit hours (technical/vocational/military courses) in an occupational specialization area (OSA) is required to qualify for the program.
4. Any course listed as “approved for the Texas Core Curriculum” 010 component will meet this core requirement; however, for success in the program, completion of any two ENGL 1301/1302/2311 are required as pre-requisites for PSYC 3409.
