4. Students are required to take nine (9) hours in upper-level U.S. History electives and take nine (9) hours in upper-level non-U.S. History electives. See course descriptions for which courses meet this requirement.
5. Please note the following courses require a grade of 'C' or better: 12 credit hours of English, College Algebra, approved Educational Psychology course, and 15 credit hours in the certification subject area.
