- 1. For the Occupational Specialization credits, students must have a minimum of 12 semester credit hours consisting of technical, vocational, and military training and may include academic electives to complete the maximum allowable 33 semester credit hours.
- 2. Not all Degree Requirement courses are completed with the AAS. Student will need to complete these remaining lower-level courses at Dallas College. Please discuss the consortium agreement procedure with a TAMUCT financial aid advisor.
- 3. Lower-Level Electives, Any Level Electives, Component Area Options, or Degree Requirements (DEG REQ) may consist of the FOS courses: CRIJ 1301, CRIJ 1306, CRIJ 1310, CRIJ 2313, CRIJ 2328.
- 4. Course should be taken in the first semester.
