For help with pathway planning, student should speak with an <u>academic advisor</u>. This pathway is intended for planning and visualization purposes only.

- 1. For the Occupational Specialization credits, students must have a minimum of 12 semester credit hours consisting of technical, vocational, and military training and may include academic electives to complete the maximum allowable 42 semester credit hours.
- 2. Social Work Designated Elective select one of the following: CRIJ 1307, DAAC 1391, SCWK 1313 or SCWK 2307.
- 3. Not all Degree Requirement courses are completed with the AAS. Student will need to complete these remaining lower-level courses at Dallas College. Please discuss the consortium agreement procedure with a TAMUCT financial aid advisor.
- 4. Biology course excludes Nutrition.
