1. For the Occupational Specialization credits, students must have a minimum of 12 semester credit hours consisting of technical, vocational, and military training and may include academic electives to complete the maximum allowable 42 semester credit hours.

2. Not all Degree Requirement courses are completed with the Certification. Student will need to complete these remaining lower-level courses at Dallas College. Please discuss the consortium agreement procedure with a TAMUCT financial aid advisor.

3. Biology Course excludes Nutrition.

4. Any-level electives may be taken at either at Texas A&M University-Central Texas or at Dallas College. Please consult with an academic advisor prior to selecting any-level electives.

5. Lower-Level Electives, Any Level Electives, Component Area Options, or Degree Requirements (DEG REQ) may consist of the FOS courses: PSYC 2301, PYSC 2314, PSYC 2317, PSYC 2319, PSYC 2320, PSYC 2320, PSYC 2330.
