4. Lower-Level Electives, Any Level Electives, Component Area Options, or Degree Requirements (DEG REQ) may consist of the FOS courses: HIST 1301, HIST 1302, two of the following: HIST 2301, HIST 2311, HIST 2312, HIST 2322, HIST 2327, HIST 2328, HIST 2381.

5. All 6 hours must be from the same language; CLEP, Defense Language Certification.
