- Not all Degree Requirement courses are completed with the AS. Students will need to complete these remaining lower-level courses at the community college. Please consult a TAMUCT financial aid counselor regarding the consortium agreement process.
- 2. May include 3 hours of lower-level courses; otherwise, all electives are upper-level.
- 3. May include 9 hours of lower-level courses; otherwise, all electives are upper-level. The Department of Social Sciences includes Anthropology, Criminal Justice, Political Science, Religious Studies, and Sociology. Students may choose from any combination of these disciplines.
