Notes/Comments

The following Pathway Plan is suggested for full-time students. A part-time student will need more time to complete this pathway. For assistance with pathway planning, students should schedule an appointment with an academic advisor. This guide is for planning and visualization purposes only.

- 1. All first-time Austin Community College students with fewer than 12 SCH of successful college credit must take an EDUC success course, or equivalent, in their first semester. All other students may choose the success course or a 1 credit hour KINE course from the Health and Kinesiology department.
- Foreign language hours must be in the same language.
- 3. Restricted Elective: select from SPCH 2389 (department approval required), COMM 1307, COMM 2302, a Foreign Language IV course in the same language, or a literature course from the Language, Philosophy, and Culture section of the Core Curriculum Course List.
- 4. Not all Degree Requirement courses are completed with the AA. Students will need to complete these remaining lower-level courses at the community college. Please consult a TAMUCT financial aid counselor regarding the consortium agreement process.
- 5. Any-level electives may be taken at either at Texas A&M University-Central Texas or another institution. Please consult an academic advisor prior to selecting any-level electives.
- 6. Each Minor listed requires 12 hours of Upper-Level electives and 6 hours of Lower-level electives (or Any Level Elective) from the same concentration (Minor) area. Refer to the listings of Undergraduate Minors to choose the three different minors and their respective requirements for this degree.
- Coursework includes but is not limited to: BUSI 3301, PSYC 3409, SOWK 3300, BIOL 3380, HIST 3300, ENGL 3330, POLI 3330, and SOSC 3300. Please meet with your academic advisor for course recommendations.
