- (1) Select ENGL 2327, ENGL 2328, ENGL 2351, or a literature course from the Component Area Option section of the Core Curriculum Course List.
- (2) Select from COMM 2389 (department approval required); or SPAN 1412 or another foreign language course. Foreign language hours must be in the same language.
- (3) Any-level electives may be taken at either at Texas A&M University-Central Texas or another institution. Please consult an academic advisor prior to selecting any-level electives.
- (4) Not all Degree Requirement courses are completed with the AA. Student will need to complete these remaining lower-level courses at the community college. Please consult a TAMUCT financial aid counselor regarding the consortium agreement process
