- 2. Any-level electives may be taken at either at Texas A&M University-Central Texas or another institution. Please consult with an academic advisor prior to selecting any-level electives.
- 3. Adding an Education Minor will increase the total credits and possibly the length to complete the degree. Please consult with an academic advisor.
- 4. Please note the following courses require a grade of 'C' or better: 12 credit hours of English, College Algebra, approved Educational Psychology course, and 15 credit hours in the certification subject area.
