- 3. May include 3 hours of lower-level courses; otherwise all electives are upper-level.
- 4. May include 9 hours of lower-level courses; otherwise all electives are upper-level. Social Sciences includes the following disciplines: Anthropology, Criminal Justice, Political Science, Religious Studies, and Sociology.
