- 2. 12 hours of a Foreign Language or 12 hours of any combination of upper-level Linguistics or Foreign Language courses.
- 3. The following courses require a grade of 'C' or better: 12 credit hours of English, College Algebra, approved Educational Psychology course, and 15 credit hours in the certification subject area.
