- 3. ENGL 3320 or ENGL 3330 allowed for the requirement.
- 4. Biology Elective excludes Nutrition.
- 5. The following courses require a grade of 'C' or better: 12 credit hours of English, College Algebra, and approved Educational Psychology course and completion of 15 credit hours in the certification subject area.
