- 2. Restricted Electives must be chosen from among the following courses: ANTH 2351, GEOG 1302, ECON 2301, ECON 2302, CRIJ 1301, PSYC 2306, PSYC 2316.
- 3. Students can also fulfill this degree requirement by enrolling in SOWK 3300.
- 4. Students can also fulfill this degree requirement by enrolling in SOWK 3302.
- 5. A summer semester may be required to meet degree requirements and the coursework which leads up to the field placement courses.
