In-Class Services

Requests for CART/interpreter for classes are done during your first meeting with the A&I office. If you haven't requested accommodations with A&I, please complete the [Access and Inclusion Intake form](#) and upload documentation.

Outside of Class Services

To request an interpreter/CART for a meeting, workshop, or event, fill out the [Interpreter/Captioning Request Form](#) . Be sure to provide detailed meeting information.

Tuition Exemption for Blind or Deaf Students

Students who are Texas residents and are blind/and or deaf may be eligible for a tuition exemption.

All exemptions are processed through the Office of Student Financial Assistance. Claims for exemption from any charges must be supported by evidence sufficient to enable the Office of Student Financial Assistance to verify the student exempt status and determine the duration of the exemption and the charges to which it is applicable.
