Application for Legislative Office (Voting Senate Seats)

Requirements for Legislative Officers as Stated in the SGA Constitution***:

Legislative Officers (voting Senators) must maintain a minimum cumulative 2.0 GPA (3.0 GPA for graduate student Senators) and be in good standing with the university. Each voting Senator must be an SGA member for one academic semester at the time he or she takes office (June 1st).

Academic Program Senator Duties

These Senators represent the students of specific academic programs at the university (English, social work, etc.), and each academic Senator must be enrolled in the degree program that he or she represents. Academic Senators must actively engage their constituents and professors in order to identify and solve student-related issues, especially those related to their specific programs.

At-Large Senator Duties

The SGA's four At-Large Senators represent the general interests of the entire student body of TAMUCT, and each At-Large Senator may be enrolled in any degree program at the university. At-Large Senators are charged with working to identify and solve broad student-related issues that impact large portions of the student body, such as student parking, tuition, and fees.

Graduate Student Senator Duties

The three graduate student Senators represent the graduate students of the university's three academic schools (Arts & Sciences, Business Admin, and Education), and each graduate student Senator must be enrolled in a graduate degree program in the academic school that he or she represents. Graduate Senators are responsible for working to identify and solve issues specific to graduate students, such as funding/grants, research, and practicums.
