As a founding partner of **CORE Consulting**, an organization development consulting group, I served as a consultant in manufacturing and health-care industries, small service businesses, and with Federal, state and local government agencies. After completing my undergraduate studies, I entered the United States Air Force, and served principally as a fighter pilot, flying the F-4 Phantom II, the F-15 Eagle and the AT-38 Talon. During a twenty-one year career, I served four overseas tours in Asia and Europe. My duties included managerial and staff officer positions in areas of personnel, operations, training, and aircraft maintenance. I served as operational planning staff officer for two fighter wings in the Pacific theater, developing both tactical and strategic operations plans. As Chief of Quality Control for Aircraft Maintenance, I played a significant role in the achievement of the unit placing second in the 1973 Daedalian Trophy Competition award given to the best aircraft maintenance unit in the USAF. As Chief of Academic Training, I lead the design and development of the academic classroom and simulation training portions of the USAF Fighter Lead-In Training Program in which new fighter pilots received their initial fighter tactics training and served as the first Chief of Academics. As a staff officer in the Headquarters United States Air Forces Europe, I served a Chief of Air Defense Readiness, having a principal role in designing training exercises for European fighter units, the identification of readiness shortfalls in the air defenses and management of strategies to remedy those shortfalls. During a tour in Korea, I served as Senior Air

Liaison Officer to the Korean Army. As a junior officer, I lead work studies of aircraft maintenance units and development manning tables for those organizations.

4. Academic Advising:

This is an area of my duties that I particularly enjoy and take very seriously. My advising load is approximately fifty undergraduate HRM majors and a few management majors. As our Central Texas students are mostly non-traditional students with extensive work from two or more other institutions, their situations are very different from that of traditional students. Often, it takes a bit of creativity to maximize the useful credit of that prior work. Many still have some lower level work to complete concurrently at other schools. These factors require careful planning to enable them to complete the remaining degree requirements in a reasonable time frame. I also delight in aiding students in the pursuit of career advancement. One rewarding situation was seeing an US Army degree completion student selected to go on to graduate school to become a member of the faculty at West Point. Another student, BBA-HRMG graduate and current MS-HRM student was recently hired as benefits manager with a local manufacturing firm, with the intent of replacing the HRM manager in about six months. Besides working with students in their Academic planning, I have often been called upon to counsel with students regarding various issues in their personal lives.
