Procedure Summary

This standard administrative procedure provides specific guidance for the granting of honorary degrees from A&M-Central Texas.

Procedures and Responsibilities

1. NOMINATIONS

- 1.1 Nominations for honorary degrees will be submitted to the Office of the Provost for review in order to verify that the nomination packet is complete.
- 1.2 A complete nomination packet consists of digital copies of the following: letter of nomination, nominee's curriculum vitae, supporting letters, and additional supporting documentation (when provided).

2. SELECTION COMMITTEE COMPOSITION

- 2.1 The Selection Committee for Honorary Degrees is an ad hoc committee comprised of the following representatives:
 - (a) Provost and Vice President for Academic and Student Affairs – Chair
 - (b) Associate Provost/Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs
 - (c) Dean of the Graduate School
 - (d) Presiding Officer of the Faculty Advisory Council
 - (e) One College Dean
 - (f) One Professor
 - (g) One Associate Professor
- 2.2 The President will appoint the appropriate College Dean, Professor, and Associate Professor to the ad hoc committee after being informed by the Office of the Provost of a nomination.
- 2.3 The selection committee must have a majority vote in favor of granting the honorary degree before the recommendation can be forwarded to the President for approval and submission to the Board of Regents.
